



Africans born abroad acquire the nationality of that State, becoming foreigners to African nations.

In Cape Verde, the diaspora is mainly identified with remittances contributing to country economy.

In 2022, US\$334 million were sent to Cape Verdean families to purchase basic food and cover expenses related to health, education, funding distinct incomegenerating activities, etc.
